**LIBC–Lummi Higher Education Scholarship**

**2007-08 LIBC/Lummi Higher Education Application**  
**Priority deadline: August 31, 2007**

The following five documents are required to apply for the LIBC Lummi Higher Education Scholarship.

1. **Lummi Tribal Enrollment Verification** *Copy of enrollment card, CDIB, or letter from the Lummi Tribe*
2. **LIBC Lummi Higher Ed Scholarships Application or Renewal application** (*COMPLETE*)
3. **Statement of Educational/Career Goals – Transfer student must update**
4. **Official College Transcripts from the last college attended**
5. **Copy of Registration for current college courses**

***NOTE: If there are outstanding documents not yet received, a Lummi Higher Education Scholarship cannot be awarded.***

Grades and registration are due by the priority deadlines to ensure continued funding for the student. It is the student's responsibility to submit a complete application as well as grades and registration by the priority deadlines:

Fall 2007 term:	August 31
Winter 2008 term:	January 2
Spring 2008 term:	March 22

The awards are given to students with complete applications. Students are not considered for funding until all documents have been received. There will be a waiting list once funds are expended. All students on the waiting list were eventually funded in 2006-07, but there is no guarantee of funds for any or all of the 2007-08 students who may be on the waiting list. No funds are available for summer terms.

Students must be attending an accredited institution of higher education—a technical college, community college or a 4 year college or university. Graduate students may apply, but funds are limited beyond the undergraduate level.

Fulltime students are awarded \$3000 for the 2007-08 school year. The funds are sent each term to the financial aid office at the college the student is attending. Recipients must maintain satisfactory academic progress to continue receiving the scholarship, which means all funded credits are earned and a 2.0 grade point average is achieved each term. There is a petition process for reinstatement consideration. However, petitions may be denied and aid suspended.

Fulltime:	\$1000 quarter/ \$1500 semester
3/4 Time:	\$750 quarter/ \$1125 semester
Half Time:	\$500 quarter/ \$750 semester

Less than half time students are ineligible for funds at this time.
