Northwest Commission on Colleges and Universities to conduct comprehensive evaluation of Northwest Indian College April 12-14, 2017.

As part of the regular accreditation cycle, Northwest Indian College will undergo a site visit by a peer-evaluation team from the Northwest Commission on Colleges and Universities (NWCCU) April 12-14, 2017. The site visit is part of Northwest Indian College's Year Seven Evaluation, a comprehensive review of the College's compliance and accreditation standards. Northwest Indian College has been continually accredited since 1993 at the associate degree level, became accredited at the baccalaureate degree level in 2010, and most recently completed a Year Three Evaluation in 2014.

During this visit, the peer-evaluation team will tour Northwest Indian College, review documents, and interview students, alumni, faculty, staff, leadership, and members of the Board of Trustees. The peer-evaluation team will then submit a report to the NWCCU.

In preparation for the April visit, Northwest Indian College invites the public to submit written comments regarding the College's qualifications for accreditation. Comments must be in writing, signed, and received no later than March 12, 2017 at the address below.
