Dear Student,

Currently, all programs of study at Northwest Indian College are being redesigned and may include courses that will become inactive beginning in Spring Quarter 2014 (April 7, 2014). The courses that will become inactive are NASD 110, HIST 111, and HIST 112.

Northwest Indian College has approved program substitution requirements for the above mentioned courses. In lieu of the required NASD 110 course students will be expected to complete Cultural Sovereignty (CSOV) 101. In lieu of both HIST 111 and HIST 112, students will be expected to complete CSOV 120. We will continue to offer HIST 112 only for students who have completed NASD 110 and HIST 111. For more details regarding the substitutions, please refer to the attached diagram.

The Cultural Sovereignty courses align with both our Institutional Mission and Outcomes. These courses also provide foundational knowledge for our Bachelor programs.

The Faculty, Advisors, and Site Managers will assist students with identifying course selection and program completion.
