At the completion of this course students will be able to:

- Apply arithmetic operations with whole numbers and with integers
- Apply review arithmetic operations with fractions and decimals
- Apply percentages in applications
- Demonstrate intermediate knowledge of ratios, rates, proportions, and their applications
- Demonstrate knowledge of informal geometry and units
- Measurement of (U.S. Customary and Metric Systems)
- Demonstrate basic knowledge of descriptive statistics and pictographs
- Demonstrate basic knowledge of linear equations (one variable) and their solutions
- Demonstrate basic ability to graph linear equation (in two variables)
- Demonstrate initial knowledge of algebraic expressions and solving simple equations
- Utilize basic critical thinking skill in mathematics
