The Associate of Arts and Sciences General Direct Transfer Degree is designed for students to explore and develop skills in global issues, communication, natural sciences, cultural awareness, social conditions and critical thinking.

This degree is designed for students who are interested in transferring to a four-year college or university to complete a bachelor's degree. The General Direct Transfer Degree requires a minimum of 20 credits coded as Native American Studies in at least three distribution areas.

Interested students should consult with a NWIC advisor to determine the appropriate courses for their area of interest.
