4. To appreciate the perpetuation of this art form in a land where, “every man is a painter and sculptor” (Holm, 5).
5. Convey specific information about history, cultural significance, styles of representation, interpretation, artifacts, and artistic practices.
6. Gain an appreciation and awareness of the importance and cultural significance of Northwest Coast Native art.
