Section 1: SATISFACTORY ACADEMIC PROGRESS POLICY

A. Approval Authority

The NWIC Board of Trustees is responsible for the final approval of this policy. The NWIC Academic Standards Committee has reviewed and approved this policy. The NWIC Administrative Team has reviewed and submitted this policy consistent with policy development procedures before submission to the NWIC Board of Trustees.

B. Purpose of the Policy

The purpose of this Policy is to align our institution's goals and definition of student success to ensure that students are making satisfactory progress towards degree completion. The criteria to determine the student's progress is inclusive of students in various situations and is reflective of our student body.

Also note, the policy is separate from the current Federal regulations for Financial Aid regarding SAP.

C. Policy Statement

The Policy is as follows:

NWIC is committed to facilitating student success. Students maintaining either a cumulative or the most recent quarterly 2.0 grade point average are considered to be making satisfactory academic progress in their program of study.
