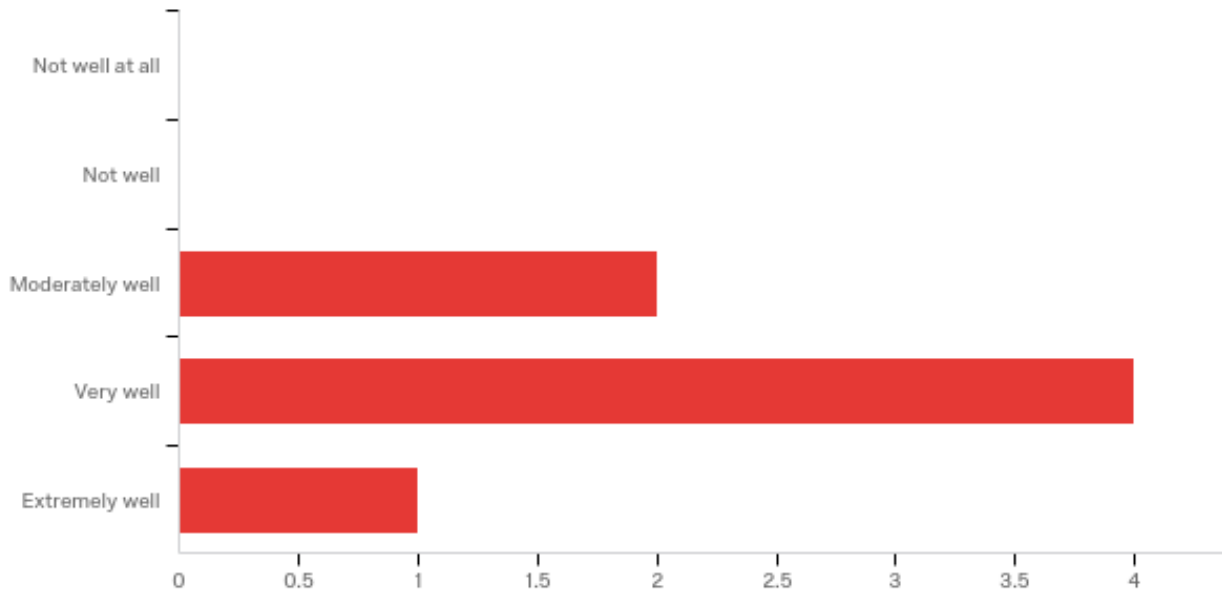

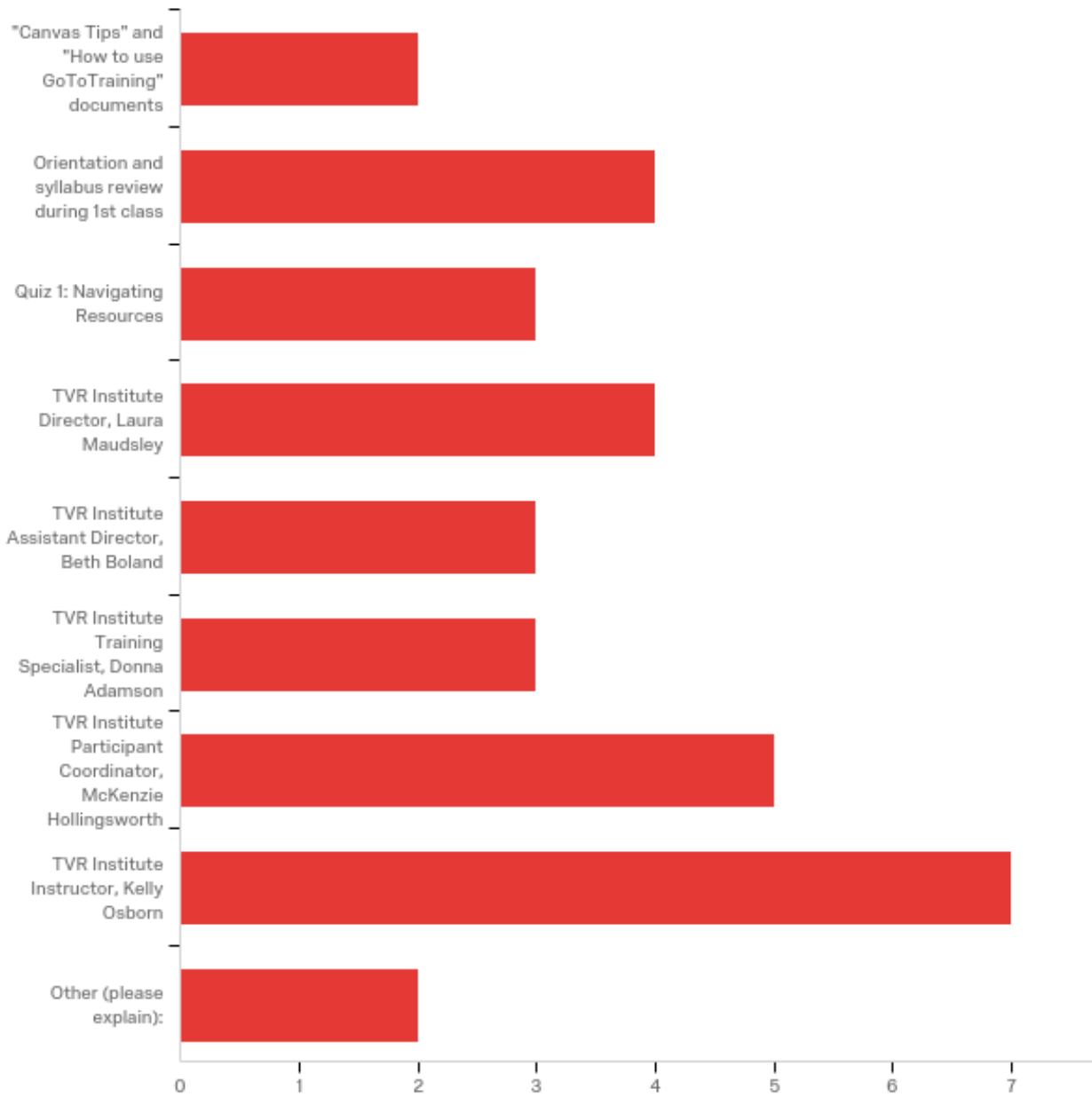
It has assisted me with getting a stronger understanding of the foundation of tribal vocational rehabilitation.

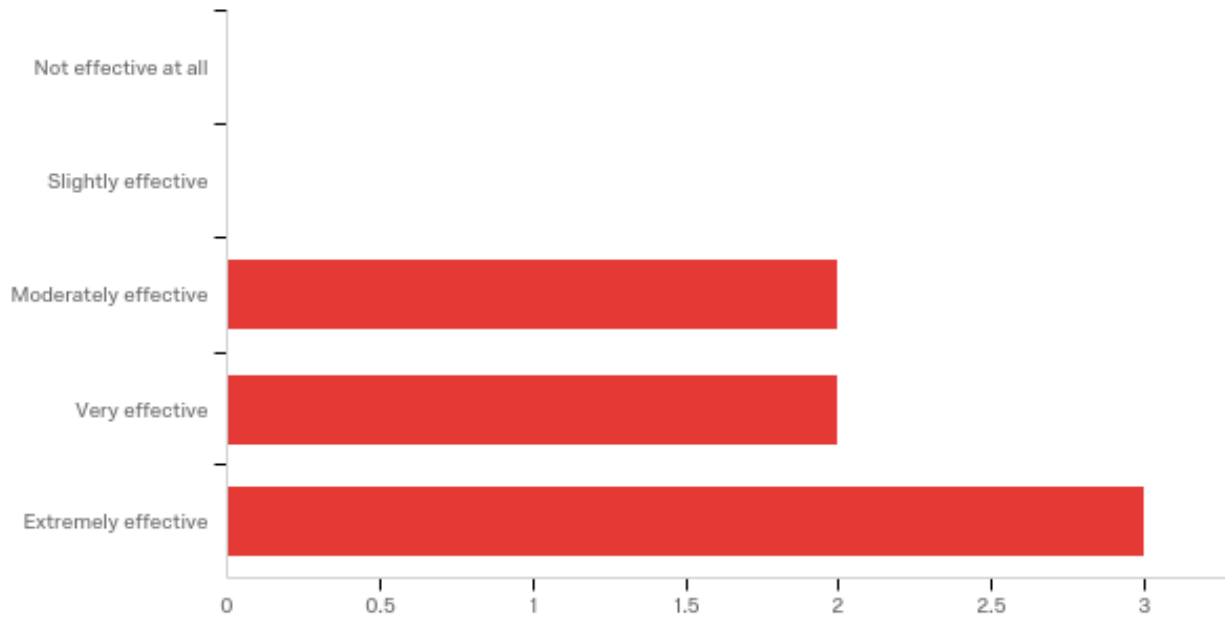

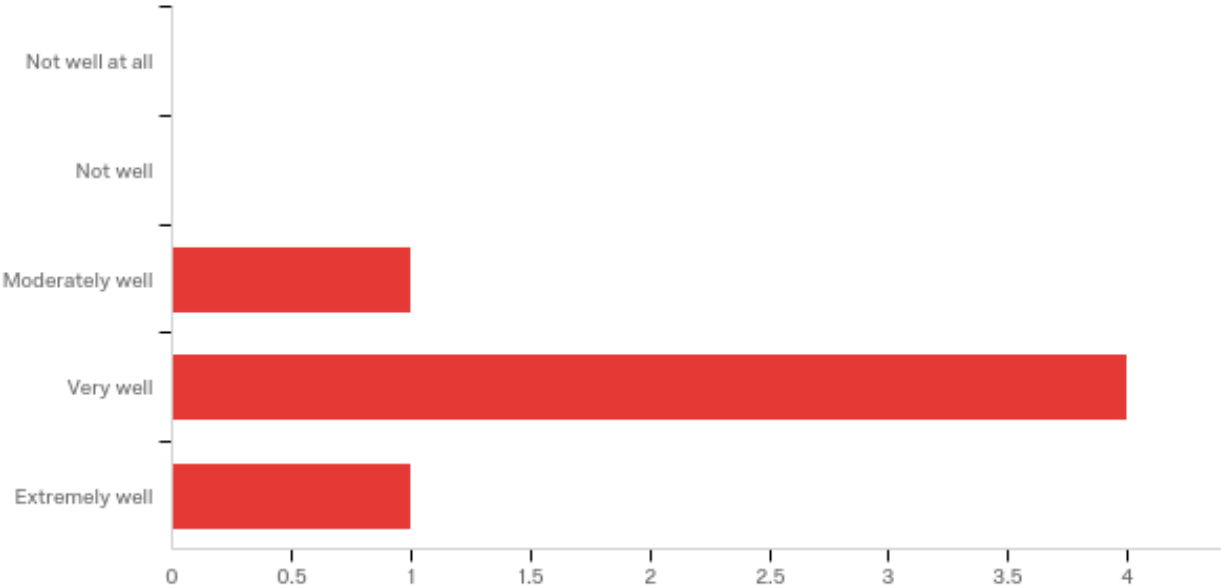
How satisfied were you with this course?

I has just reinforced the fact that I am on the right track and am where I want to be.

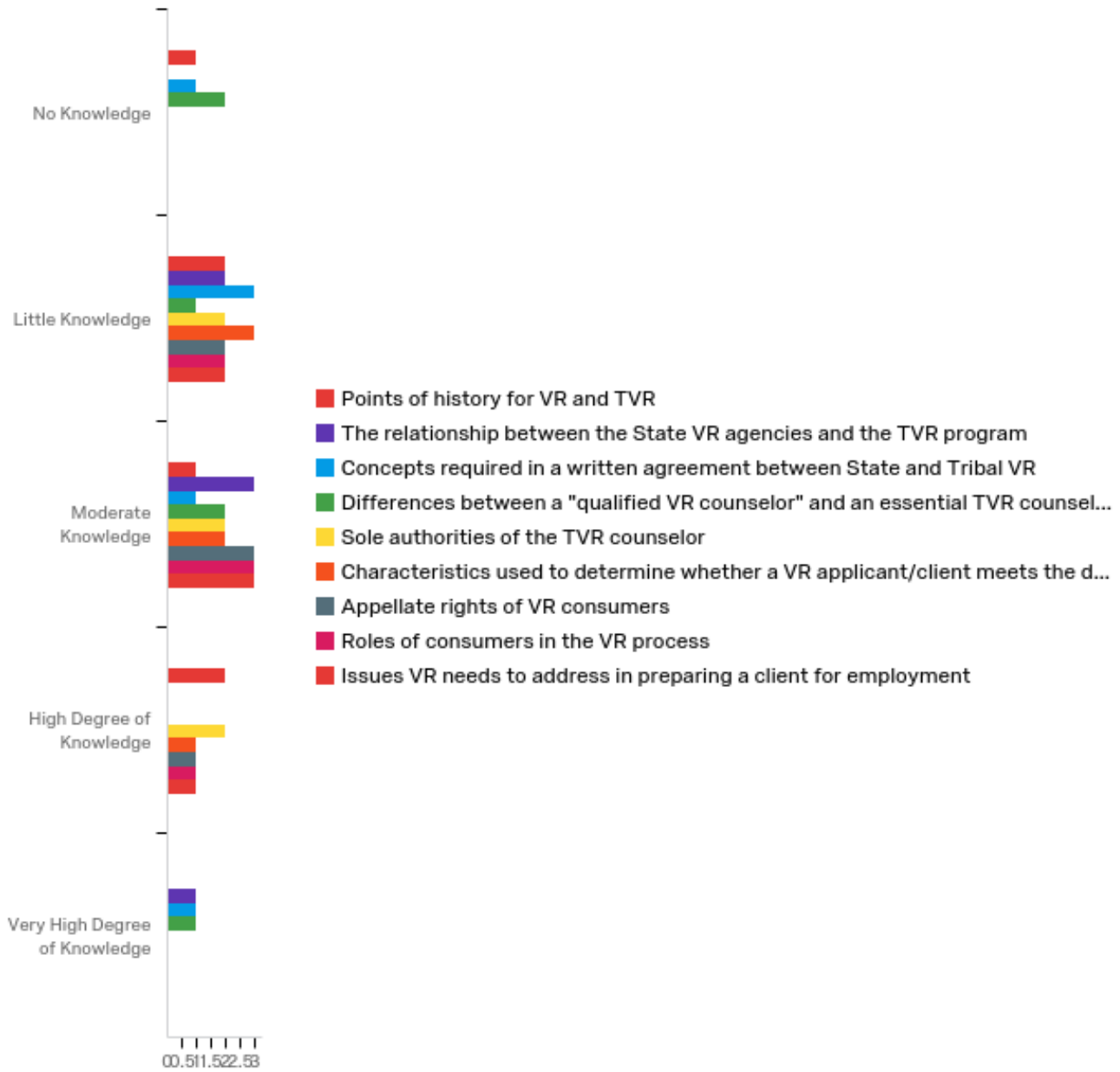
This course has given me a quality understanding of Tribal VR programs in general, the regulations behind them, and how to better improve the program I work for.

I am going to be a Vocational Rehabilitation counselor so I will use it there.

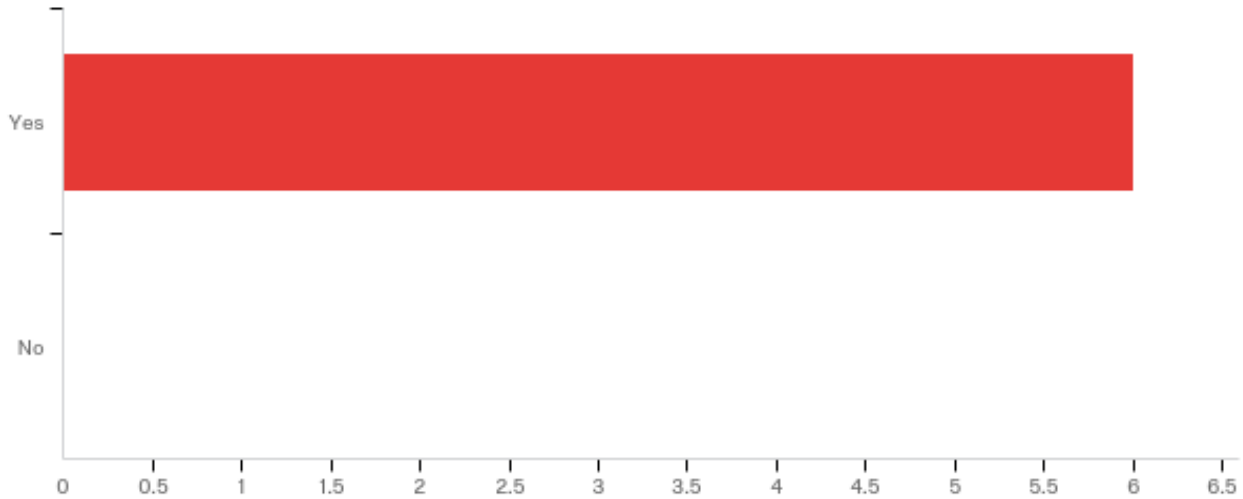
I will be finalizing policy and procedures documents for my program in the near future. This course will be very influential on how that is completed.

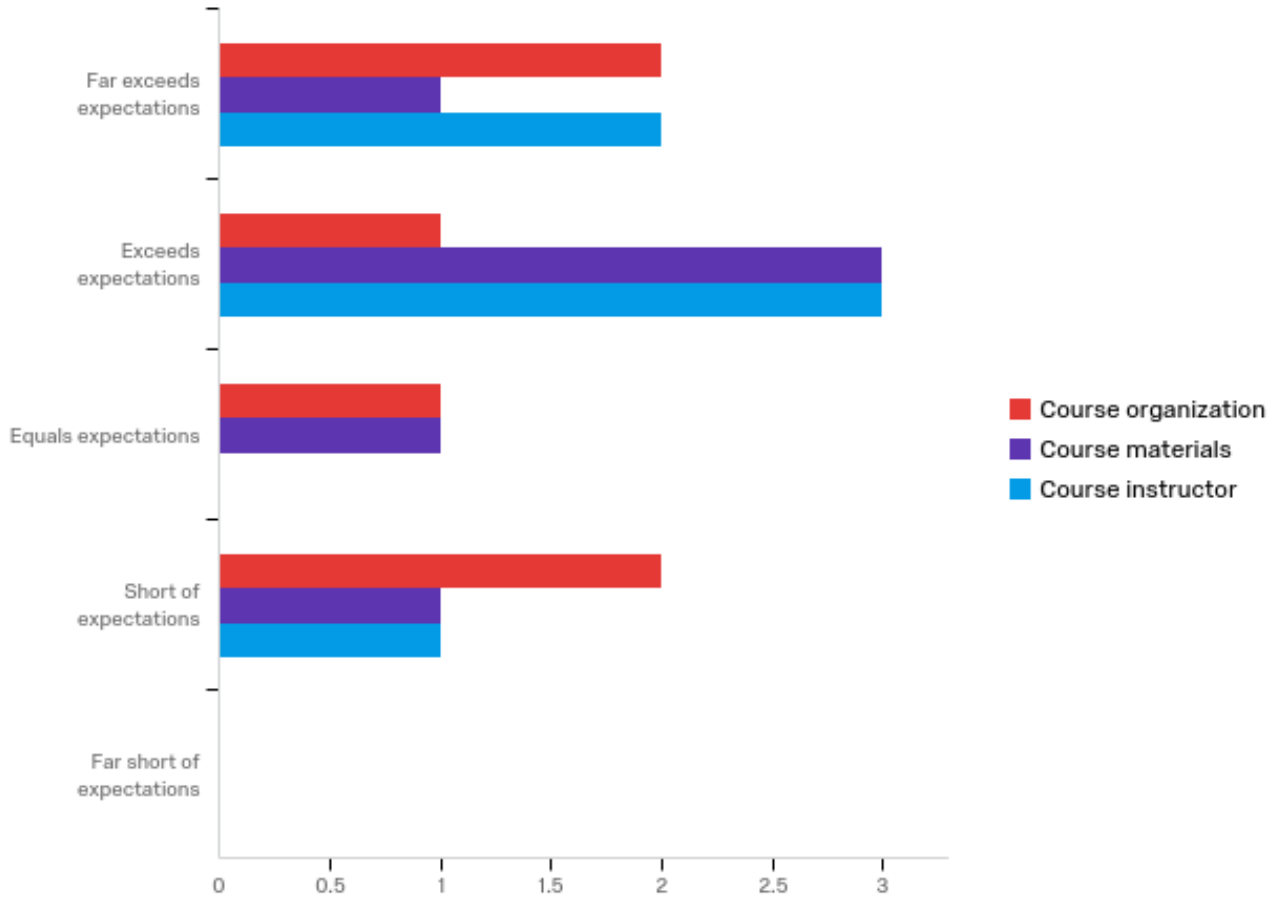
Shared with coworkers in casual work related conversations and during staff meetings.

State voc rehab staff and our office

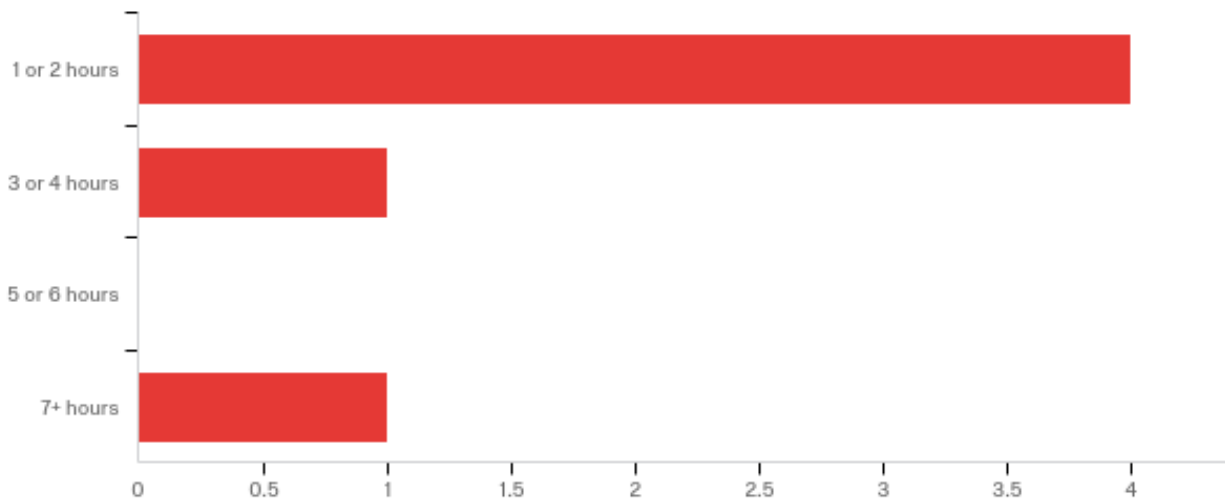
Were having TVR people coming from all over Alaska and we are doing the presentation to them this morning

Usually with staff one-on-one seeking guidance from me.

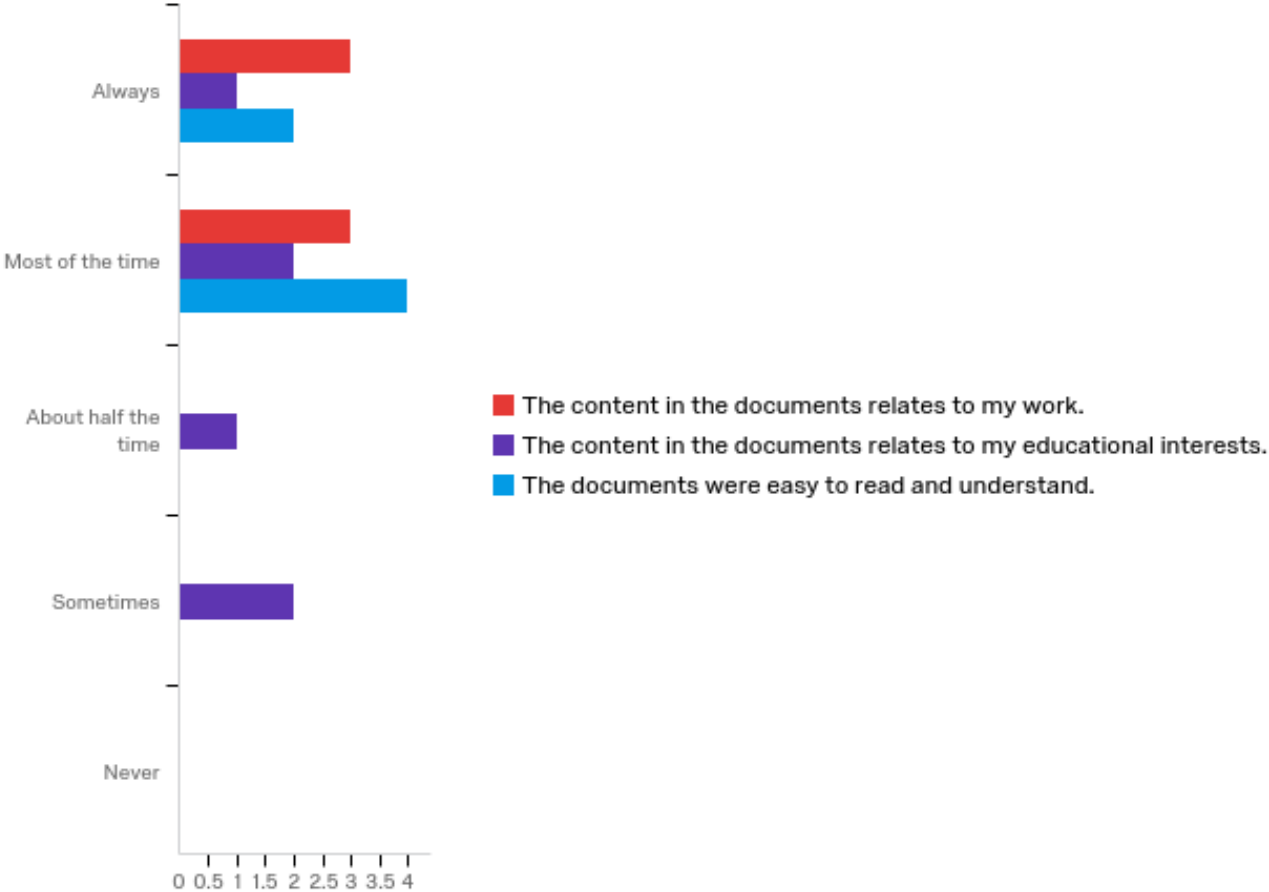

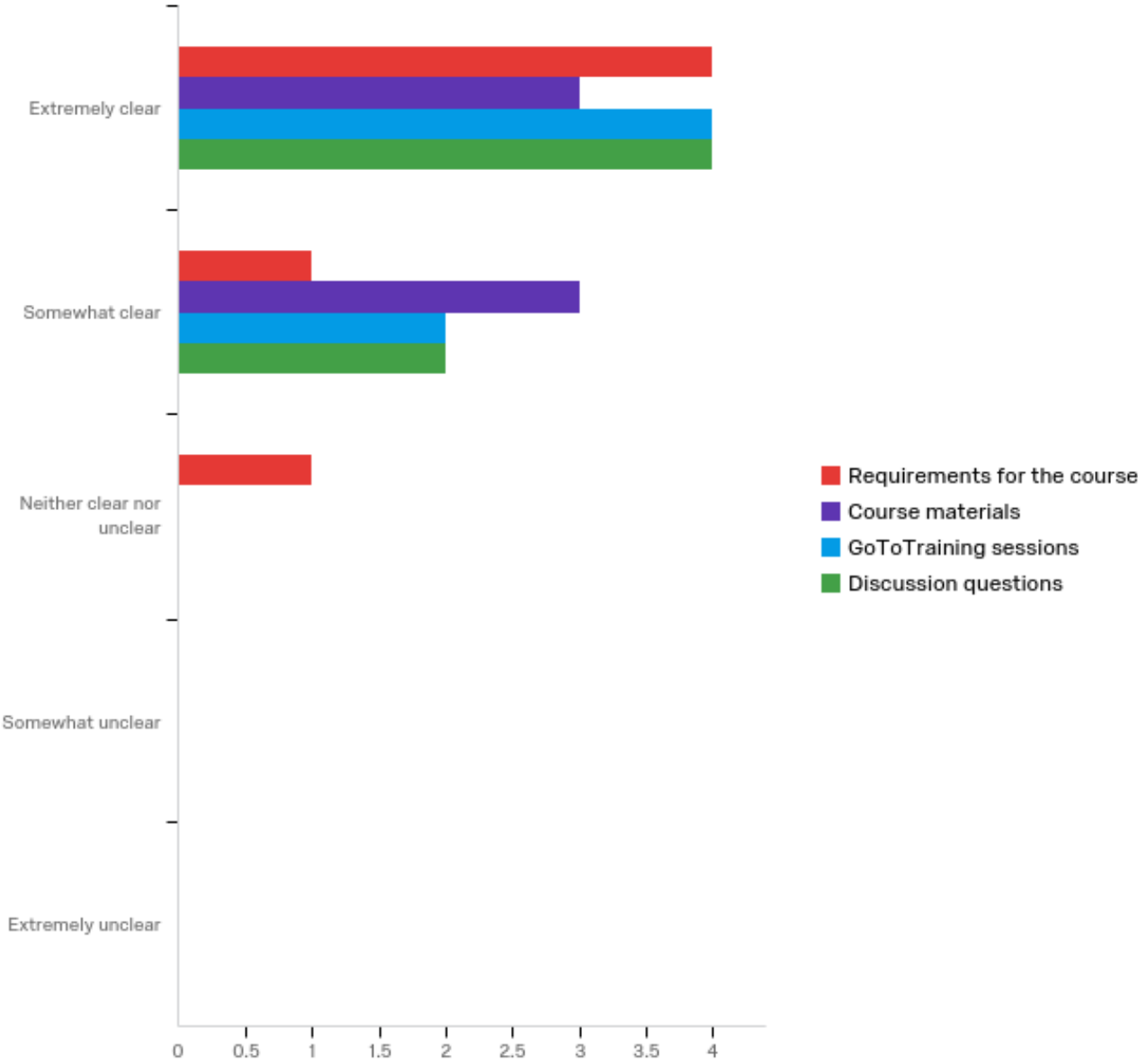
What is the average number of hours per week that you spend completing course requirements outside of the GoToTraining sessions?



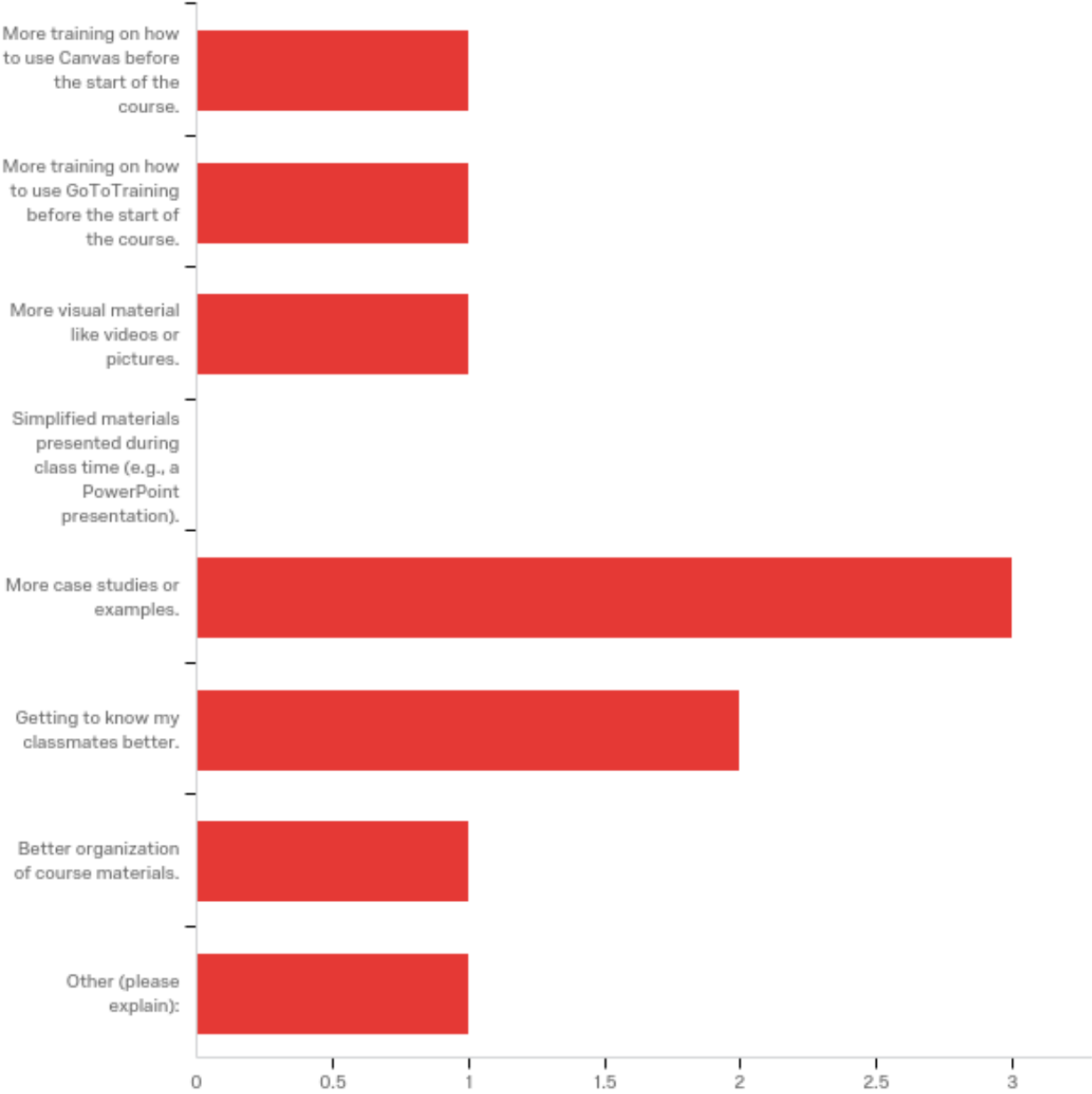
