- \Rightarrow Submit a copy of your High School or GED Unofficial Transcripts (or Diploma) (REQUIRED)
- ⇒ Complete the Northwest Indian College Application for Admissions
- ⇒ **Submit Verification of Tribal Affiliation** (copy of front and back of enrollment card, CDIB, or letter from Tribe/ Village verifying enrollment or status). This is very important in determining tuition rate.
- ⇒ Submit Official Transcripts from all colleges attended (if applicable). If you would like credits evaluated toward your program of study at NWIC, please submit a Transfer Evaluation Request From
- ⇒ Complete Federal Financial Aid Form (FAFSA for current year). Complete online at www.fafsa.ed.gov
- ⇒ Submit Financial Aid Data Sheet to the NWIC Financial Aid office
- ⇒ Submit Resident Life Center (Housing) Application (Lummi Campus Student Only)

Assessment and Advising

- ⇒ Make an appointment for a placement test. After test, bring scores to an advisor to register for classes.
- ⇒ Make an appointment with advisor for Site Coordinator to discuss program needs and class schedule.
- ⇒ Check with Financial Aid office regarding status of financial aid application. Students must be accepted to NWIC to receive Financial Aid. Check with the office of admissions if you have not received a Acceptance Letter.
