SCOPE OF WORK

Under the direct supervision of the Muckleshoot Site Manager, the Math Tutor will facilitate students in the development of learning skills. The Math Tutor is expected to maintain a teaching relationship with several NWIC students throughout the academic school year, providing tutorial services while acting as a mentor. This position also includes some responsibilities as a grader and some data entry.

DUTIES & RESPONSIBILITIES

- Comfortable working with one or possibly groups of students.
- Can enter data and treat it as confidential.
- Perform other related duties as appropriately assigned by supervisor.
- Be a role model for other students.
- Attend weekly meetings with instructors to discuss upcoming material and common expectations.

- Passed Math 107 or an equivalent statistics course at another college with a B or better
- Have taken Chemistry 111 and 112 or plan to do so in the next year
- Direct experience working with Native Americans or an ability to work with Native American people with an understanding of and sensitivity to the special educational needs and an appreciation for their culture.
