



## **Shelter In Place Order No.6.2 Phase IV: Staying Safe Lummi Nation**

Effective: June 30, 2021 through July 30, 2021 at 11:59pm

**WHY** As of June 26, 2021, the Lummi Nation has had 530 confirmed cases including 1 active case and 525 recovered. The recent case spikes across the U.S. are tied to social and family gatherings inside of homes.

### **WHAT PHASE ARE WE IN?**

The LIBC approved Shelter in Place Order Phase IV: Staying Safe Lummi Nation shall be in effect until July 30, 2021. Below highlights important changes to the Shelter in Place Order.

### **SOCIAL DISTANCING**

Every person shall always maintain social distancing of at least six feet from any other person when they are outside their residence as reasonably possible.

### **GATHERINGS**

- Outside gatherings of 100% capacity.
- 100% capacity for people indoors any public gathering over 20 people with mask wearing and social distancing, a sign-in sheet must be available for contact tracing.
- Funerals - Follow protocols approved by LIBC
- All congregate activities need to practice social distancing and wear masks/face coverings
- All recreation activities may resume with social distancing as much as possible.
- Phase IV Youth Sports – continue to follow Phase III guidelines.

### **TRAVEL**

- Fully vaccinated people (at least 14 days after second shot) may continue all travel without quarantine upon return.
- Unvaccinated people must continue to quarantine upon return.
- Unvaccinated people must get a viral test within 3-5 days after travel out of state/by plane or quarantine for 10 days.

## **VACCINATION – GET VACCINATED – MASK MANDATED**

### **FACE COVERINGS**

Every person **MUST** wear a face covering that covers their nose and mouth when in any indoor or outdoor public setting except in the following:

- When they are eating or drinking,
- When communicating with a person who is deaf or hearing impaired and not wearing a face cover is essential to communicating;

People who don't need to wear a mask:

- Children under the age of six,
- Others who wearing a mask may be difficult due to medical illness or intellectual disability.
